## Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

*Luke 21:5-19*

When I was a kid growing up in New England, I'd occasionally go on a whale watch. Once we went out with calm waters and clear skies. But on the way back in, the sea got rough. I was just a kid, and I remember thinking we should turn left or right toward the shoreline I could see. But the pilot of the boat kept going straight — right into the waves — focused on a small, discouragingly distant lighthouse. Even when it flickered in and out of sight, he stayed the course. He knew where he was going.

That image comes to mind when I hear Jesus' words in today's Gospel regarding false messiahs: "Do not follow them" (Luke 21:8). In times of chaos or uncertainty, there are always voices offering easier routes, promising false safety, claiming to speak for God. But Jesus isn't found in the loudest voice or the nearest shoreline. He is steady, like a lighthouse in the storm.

The tribulation of which Jesus speaks — it's real. It happened to the Temple, it happened to Him, it happens in the Church, and it will come to each of us. But the command is not to panic. It's to endure. To keep steering toward Him. Faith isn't about having all the answers or dodging every wave. It's about knowing where the lighthouse is — and trusting it enough to keep going, especially when false safety beckons us to stop. — *Father John Muir* ©LPI





### From The Earth Ministry: Have an Eco-friendly Thanksgiving



The DNR says that food waste is the largest component of trash found in Wisconsin landfills. Over the holidays trash going to landfills increases by about 25%. According to the Natural Resources Defense Council, about 200 million pounds of Thanksgiving turkey meat are thrown out. The decomposing waste releases an enormous amount of methane, a nasty greenhouse gas.

So how can we combat this waste? First of all, “right size” your turkey. The general rule is 1.5 pounds of turkey per person, which decreases to 8 ounces per guest for boneless meat. Secondly, buy organic turkey and “all the trimmings” locally if possible. Buying locally means your food hasn’t traveled very far, producing less pollution from trucks and often less packaging.

There are lots of other things you can do to reduce the carbon footprint of your Thanksgiving celebration. Just enter “eco-friendly Thanksgiving” into your search engine, and you will get millions of resource citations.

### Devotions, Explained! Advent Wreath

The Advent Wreath as we know it today is a modern spin on an ancient practice — or rather, several of them.

Christians have always utilized candles to illustrate the metaphor of Christ as the “great light” shining on a people waiting in darkness (Isaiah 9:2). Historians tell us that pre-Christian societies in Europe also viewed candles as symbolic of the coming light of spring, and may have used wreaths of natural material along with these candles. Traditions and rituals surrounding an “Advent Wreath” are often thought to have originated in the Lutheran tradition in 16th-century Germany. Today, Advent Wreaths are a practice embraced by most Christians in the Western world.

An Advent Wreath consists of a circle of evergreen and four candles, one for each week of Advent. Three of the candles are purple; one is rose, representing Gaudete Sunday, a time of rejoicing at the closeness of Christmas. In Catholicism, Advent Wreaths are blessed on the First Sunday of Advent. For Advent Wreaths in private homes, it is appropriate for a family member to perform the blessing. ©LPi

## Hurricane Melissa Recovery | Catholic Relief Services

Catholic Relief Services, which acts on behalf of the Catholic Church to assist people outside the United States, is helping those affected by Hurricane Melissa. The powerful storm swept across Jamaica, Haiti and Cuba in late October. 
