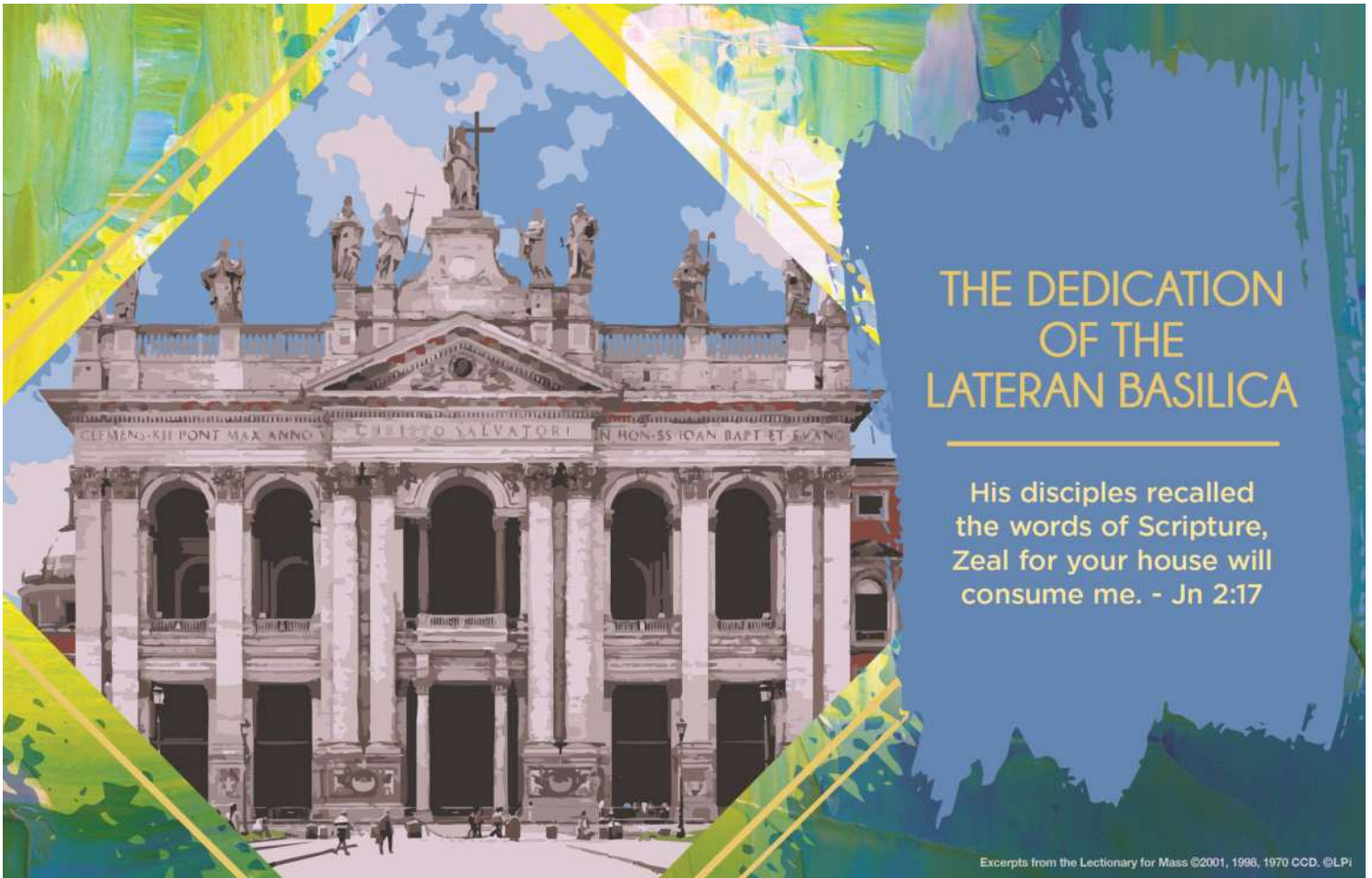

## The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

*John 2:13-22*

When I was 22, I entered St. Peter's Basilica for the first time. It floored me. I could hardly take it in, its grandeur, majestic arches, vibrant colors, and the light that danced through its high windows. Somehow, amidst such splendor, I felt an overwhelming sense of belonging, as if I had finally come home.

Jesus reorients how we Catholics see sacred buildings. In today's Gospel he says, **“Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up” (John 2:13-22)**. His riddle implies, shockingly, that his own body is now the fundamental dwelling place of God and humanity. The temple in Jerusalem has been superseded.

In our churches today — whether they mirror the basilica's grandeur or embrace humble simplicity — we experience architectural symbols of Christ's risen body. It is no accident we call them “churches”: they make visible in brick-and-mortar Christ's body which is made up of the living stones we call Christians. Each church building, like St. John Lateran in Rome, or St. Peter's, or any other, is meant to be a vibrant sign of Christ's resurrected body. We should cherish and protect our churches as places where heaven touches earth, where we, as a community, are raised to the fullness of life in Christ. — *Father John Muir* ©LPi

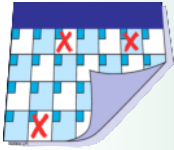

### St. Therese Sharing Weekend is This Weekend – November 9

This month's Sharing recipient is the Milwaukee VA Fisher House. The Fisher House is located on the Clement J. Zablocki VA Medical Center campus. The Fisher House's mission is to provide a "home away from home" for the families who need to be at the bedside of ill or injured Veterans or Service Members. The Milwaukee Fisher House is just over 13,000 square feet that features 16 private suites with walk in showers, gourmet kitchen, laundry room, dining room, office and family room. Through donations we are able to keep the kitchen fully stocked with food, snacks and drinks, as well other resources for the families that stay here. Families can stay at the Fisher House for as long as the veteran is admitted, free of charge. Veterans from all over Wisconsin, Michigan and Illinois come to the VA hospital in Milwaukee for much of their health care needs. When those families, traveling more than 50 miles, need a place to stay, the Fisher House is there for them.

There are many ways to help get involved with the Fisher House here in Milwaukee. One popular way is by preparing meals for the families that are staying. ### From The Earth Ministry: Worldwide Transition to Clean Energy

In a recent bulletin article we cited the health and economic benefits determined for Wisconsin by our transition from fossil fuels to renewable sources for generating electricity. That article is a great segue to the fact that worldwide, for the first quarter of 2025, renewable sources (34.3%) surpassed coal (33.1%) for power generation. This is a historic milestone! Populous developing countries like China and India made the largest gains in generating electricity from renewable sources. Hungary, Pakistan and Australia also made significant transitions from coal. While the US is also making gains, increasing demand leaves renewables struggling to meet consumer needs. Nonetheless, every step taken reduces the harmful effects of climate change, so we encourage you to support all efforts to reduce reliance on fossil fuels for electricity generation and transportation needs.

November 9 is the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. What is the significance of this feast?

Every diocese has a mother church, the bishop's cathedral where the diocesan church gathers and celebrates. The cathedral is the seat of the bishop's authority over the diocese. That authority is intended to be one of service to God's people, shepherding and guiding them in a truly pastoral mode.

The pope is first and foremost the Bishop of Rome, as well as the head of the Roman Catholic Church. St. John Lateran is his cathedral, and its prominence derives from that reality. St. John Lateran cathedral traces its origins to Emperor Constantine who converted a portion of the Laterani family palace into a church, and gave it to Pope Sylvester (314–335) as the papal church and residence; St. John refers to the two saints in whose honor the church is dedicated, John the Baptist and John the Evangelist. It became known as the cathedral of the pope, and its facade's inscription refers to it as “the Mother and Head of all Churches, in the City and of the World.” The universal celebration of this feast stresses the unity among Roman Catholics, as they unite themselves with the chair of Peter. ©LPi


Please join us at one of these services to celebrate the Thanksgiving Holiday:

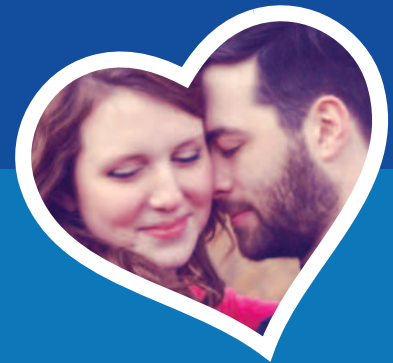

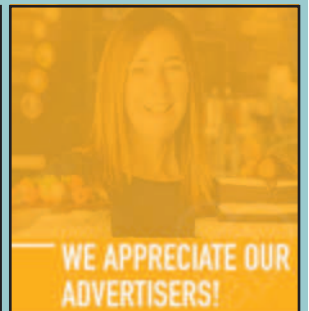
