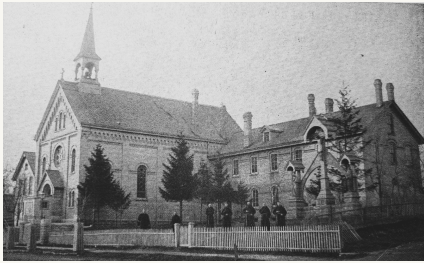


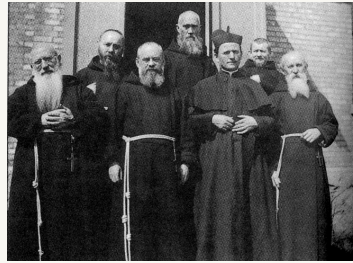
A Brief History of ST. THERESE & ST. VINCENT PALLOTTI

The churches that make up the partnership of St Vincent Pallotti and St Therese parishes have a long, intertwined history. These roots run deep in service to the community.



1879-Holy Cross Built

The first Archbishop of Milwaukee donates land on Bluemound Road to build a church and monastery to provide graveside services to the departed Catholics of Milwaukee at the distant and hard to reach Calvary Cemetery.



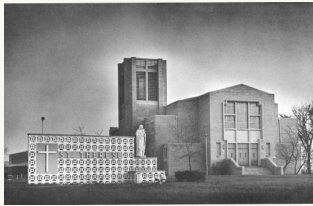
1921 - Pallotines arrive

The Capuchin Friars turn over care of Holy Cross and their ministries at Calvary Cemetery and the County Institutions to Fr. Peter Schroeder and the Pallottine Fathers of Limberg Germany.



1923 - Holy Cross Expands and Establishes St. Anthony Mission

Continually growing, Holy Cross establishes a mission to St. Anthony of Padua and erects a building 1 mile to the West near the present intersection of Bluemound & 76th St.



1956 - St Therese is Built

Due to construction of the freeway system, the Little Flower Mission is moved to 95th & Bluemound, elevated to a full parish, and renamed St. Therese Parish.



1929- Pius High School Begins

A high school track of classes, named after Pope Pius XI are begun at St Anthony's School.
1948- The burgeoning Pius High School outgrows St. Anthony's school and a new building is built across the street. At the time it was the largest Catholic High School (in size and enrollment) in Wisconsin.



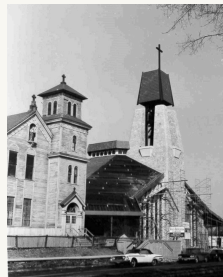
1925 - Little Flower Mission Built

In further expansion, St. Anthony establishes a mission called the Little Flower Church, built in 1925 on 94th & Adler. One of its pastors is Joseph De Maria, who will spend his priestly career in service to the Little Flower and St. Anthony's.



1958- Holy Cross Remodeled

Holy Cross is dramatically remodeled in a contemporary style.



1967- New St Anthony's Church dedicated

After years of waiting, a new, contemporary church is built to house the large St. Anthony congregation.



1998- St Vincent Pallotti Established

A merger of Holy Cross and St Anthony of Padua is completed. The new parish is named St. Vincent Pallotti (East & West).

October 2022 - Collaboration Begins

Seeking to maximize scope and reach, St Therese and St Vincent Pallotti begin a collaboration. In March of 2023, Fr. PC became the Pastor of both parishes.
