

## The Baptism of the Lord

*Matthew 3:13-17*

Apple ran a commercial not long ago called “Behind the Mac – Greatness.” It shows artists and creators, such as Kendrick Lamar, Billie Eilish, and Lady Gaga, working behind their MacBooks. The narration says, “There’s a certain kind of person who doesn’t wait for greatness. They make it.” It’s a compelling message. There’s beauty in using our gifts with passion and purpose. But there lies a hidden weight in that idea: If you are what you make, what happens when you can’t anymore? When the project fails, the passion fades, or the spotlight moves on, where is greatness then?

Today’s Gospel offers a differing vision of greatness. Jesus steps into the Jordan River. He hasn’t preached, healed, or performed a single miracle. Then the heavens open, and the Father speaks: **“You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.”** It’s not a reward for success. It’s not earned. Before he does anything “great,” Jesus receives the greatness of his identity from the Father.

And so do you. At your baptism, God said the same thing over you: “You are my beloved.” That is your true identity, not constructed or earned but received. When we see ourselves and others this way, everything changes for the better. We discover a greatness that can never be taken away.

This week, reflect on your baptism: look up the date, thank God for it, pray for those baptized with you, or visit the church where it happened. Let your identity be rooted there. — *Father John Muir* ©LPI





### Plastic Bags for Mercy Mats

Just a quick reminder that we still collect plastic shopping bags to create Mercy Mats for the homeless. The bags are folded, cut into strips and then looped together to create PLARN (plastic yarn) that is then crocheted to make the mats. Because they are plastic, moisture is kept away from the body. They are big enough for a grown man to sleep on.

You may drop them off at the entrance of all three churches where they will be picked up by a member of the Human Concerns committee. Thinner grocery bags work best. The thick Sendik's bags unfortunately don't work well for this project.

### From The Earth Ministry: Pope Leo Cements Church's Commitment to Earth Stewardship



In October 2025 at a conference attended by over 1000 religious leaders, scientists and activists, held to commemorate the 10 th anniversary Pope Francis' *Laudato Si'*, Pope Leo firmly embraced the environmental agenda Francis laid out in his historic encyclical that put the church firmly on the side of protecting the planet.

Leo thanked God for "this gift we have inherited from Pope Francis! The challenges identified in *Laudato Si'* are in fact even more relevant today than they were ten years ago."

More recently, in November 2025 at the United Nations climate talks in Brazil, Pope Leo urged the nations attending to take "concrete actions" to stop climate change, telling them "humans are failing in their response to global warming and that God's creation is 'crying out' in floods, droughts, storms and relentless heat." He went on further to add "as stewards of God's creation, we are called to act swiftly, with faith and prophecy, to protect the gift He entrusted to us."

Amen to that, most Holy Father!


### Blessed are Those Who Feed the Hungry


