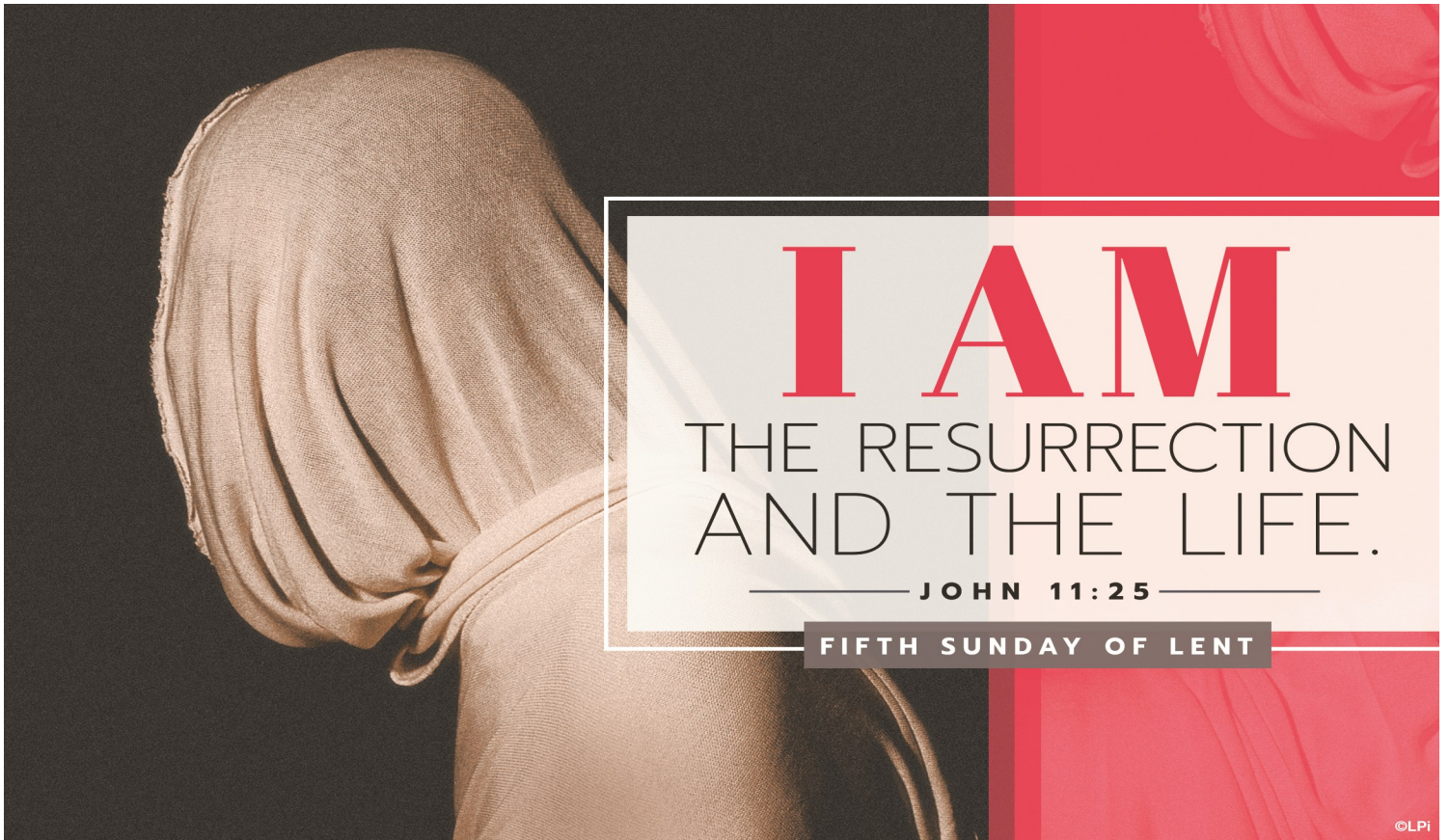

5th Sunday of Lent

John 11:1-45

A friend of mine wrote an imaginative reflection on the raising of Lazarus that caught me off guard. She proposed that when Jesus called Lazarus from the tomb, the man was not joyful but angry and annoyed. After so much suffering, maybe death felt like a release. He had finally escaped the pain. And then, suddenly, Jesus' voice cuts through the silence: **"Lazarus, come out!" (John 11:43)** The light stings his eyes. The pain returns. And now he is dragged back into a world that had broken him.

It startled me at first, but the more I sat with it, the more it made sense. Sometimes, people do not want to be raised. Not at first. Think of those in the grip of addiction, despair, or numbness. The tomb can feel safer than the risk of living again. Yet Jesus, moved by the grief and faith of others (Martha, Mary, the community) calls the dead man out. Lazarus obeys. But he is still bound, head to foot. Jesus says to the bystanders, **"Untie him and let him go" (John 11:44)**.

That is often how healing happens: slowly, reluctantly. Not just by a personal decision, but through the love and persistence of others. Resurrection is not always euphoric. It may begin in protest and confusion and only later turn to gratitude and freedom. But Christ's voice breaks through, anyway.

Lenten challenge: Who in your life needs to be called back to life? Pray for them. If that person is you, listen for the voice. It is calling even now. — *Father John Muir* ©LPi

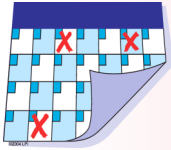

Trustee-Secretary Elections at Annual Meeting

The election of the Trustee-Secretaries for both St. Therese and St. Vincent Pallotti Parishes will take place at this year's Annual Meeting on Sunday, May 3. Ann Maher has agreed to be Fr. PC's nominee for the St. Therese Trustee-Secretary position for another two-year term of office beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2028. Fr. PC will confirm his nominee for St. Vincent Pallotti shortly.

If you are interested in the position of Trustee-Secretary at either Parish, candidates must be nominated, in writing, by 10 or more parish members. A nomination and signature form is available in the Parish Office for anyone who wishes to put their name in nomination. Any active, registered, fully-initiated parish member, at least 25 years of age, is eligible to run for Trustee-Secretary.

According to Wisconsin State Statute 187.19, "trustees are to be selected from and by the congregation." Among other duties, the Trustee Secretary serves as an ex-officio member of the Parish Pastoral Council, the Finance Council, is a member of the Board of Directors of the parish corporation, signs proxy documents and all corporate reports, and signs parish checks with Trustee Treasurer, and the Parish Director.

Nominations will close on Sunday, April 19. The election will take place at the Annual Meeting on Sunday, May 3.

Committee Updates: Parish Pastoral Council

- Father PC provided an update on efforts to combine the Parish Office staffs into one. The Personnel Committee is preparing the recommendations.
- The St. Therese and St. Vincent Pallotti Finance Councils had a “meet and greet” meeting. A team was established to look at what would have to be done to combine the parishes if we merged.
- Discussion of the Town Hall meetings and our next steps forward continued:
 - A letter from Father PC to all parishioners was reviewed.
 - Letter provides a summary of the Town Hall meetings and announces that our parishes will have the first Combined Annual Meeting on May 3 following a 10:00AM Mass at St Therese.
 - No consensus was reached on the next steps forward as two Trustees were excused from the meeting.
 - Will finalize these discussions at April 8 PPC meeting.
- Provided “From Christendom to Apostolic Mission” books to members along with a summary of the book. Members were asked to read so a thorough discussion of what this means for our parishioners and how we approach evangelism and/or missionary efforts going forward.
- PPC was provided a draft letter that will be going to all committees related to how we can gain more resources/volunteers going forward. Any input is to be forwarded to Brett so he might adjust the letter.

From The Earth Ministry:

This week's Lenten *metanoia* invitation:



Natural Habitats “God put man in the Garden of Eden to cultivate and to take care of it.” (Genesis 2:15)

This Week's Vision: From migrating monarchs to great horned owls, our parishes are blest with neighboring habitats of old growth forests and fields of wild flowers. It seems we have our own Garden of Eden so to speak with the nearby County Grounds. Natural environments are our connection to the web of life.

As Spring begins to bloom, it's important to take the time to meander the trails, feel the breeze, hear the returning birds, inhale the fresh earthy air and heal the soul. Immersing ourselves in appreciation of God's creation is an excellent way to broaden our Metanoia experience and to breathe in God's shared grace.

Keep in mind that habitats in Milwaukee and around the world are struggling with over-development chopping up habitats, litter/vandalism, and issues of climate change—such as Wisconsin's drought in 2024 and the flooding of August, 2025. They need your help.

Action Changes: A proactive way to support and maintain our natural lands is to 1) Enjoy them in real time; and 2) Get involved with volunteer Friends groups:

The Monarch Trail (themonarchtrail.org) is having a native plant sale this Spring. There's an annual migration celebration in August, an autumn milkweed seeding event, and a nesting red tail hawk in residence. See website for details.

Friends of County Grounds Park (<https://tosahistory13.wixsite.com/tosa>) has a continuous child's book hike in Sanctuary Woods, changing every 60 days from March through October. They have frequent educational nature/history hikes, buckthorn removals asking for volunteers, a Christmas bird count and nesting long-eared owls. See website for details.

Forest Exploration Center (forestexplorationcenter.org) has a great horned owl in residence, which like other raptors feeds over County Grounds Park; educational nature stops and benches on its trail for those needing to rest along the way. See website for details.

Lenten Observances for Fast and Abstinence

The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character and purpose of Lent:

- Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat each Friday of Lent.
- Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, should fast on Good Friday. Hence, on that day they should eat only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during that day. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59th birthday.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

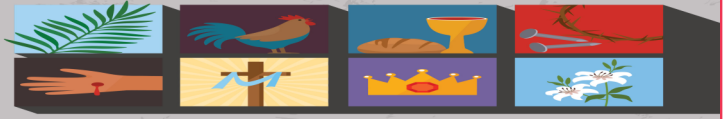

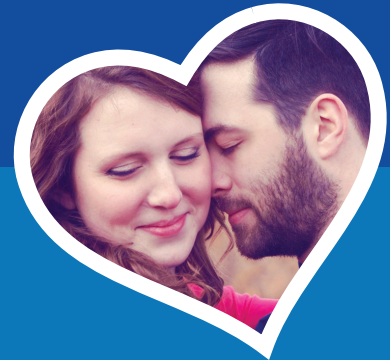
