Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Matthew 26:14-27:66

Just prior to this week's Passion narrative in St. Matthew's Gospel, there is a small, striking story describing a woman's scandalous action toward Jesus: **"A woman came up to him with an alabaster jar of costly perfumed oil, and poured it on his head"** (Matthew 26:7). The ointment was pure nard, worth more than 300 denarii. A year's wages. Maybe a dowry, maybe a family inheritance. In any case, she breaks it. She does not measure or ration. She pours it all out, irreversibly, over Jesus. Why does this image begin Holy Week?

Because what she does with the jar, Jesus will soon do with his life. The jar must be broken so the fragrance can be released. Jesus' body will be broken so His priceless divine and human love can be poured out. She gives everything, just as He is about to give everything. And He sees it: **"She has done a good thing for me"** (Matthew 26:10). Her act is lavish, impractical, scandalous in its apparent wastefulness. And He loves it. It is what Holy Week is all about.

What jar are you still holding onto? Your time? Your comfort? Your plan for how life should go? Don't just wave palms today. Let yourself be broken open so your love, too, can be poured out.

Lenten Challenge: Offer something costly to Jesus this Holy Week — not out of guilt, but love. Your attention. Your forgiveness. Your time. Break the jar. Trust that nothing poured out for Him is ever wasted. — *Father John Muir* ©LPi

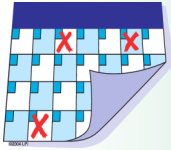

Trustee-Secretary Elections at Annual Meeting

The election of the Trustee-Secretaries for both St. Therese and St. Vincent Pallotti Parishes will take place at this year's Annual Meeting on Sunday, May 3. Ann Maher has agreed to be Fr. PC's nominee for the St. Therese Trustee-Secretary position for another two-year term of office beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2028. Lenny Schaefer has agreed to be Fr. PC's nominee for the St. Vincent Pallotti Trustee-Secretary position for another two-year term of office beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2028.

If you are interested in the position of Trustee-Secretary at either Parish, candidates must be nominated, in writing, by 10 or more parish members. A nomination and signature form is available in the Parish Office for anyone who wishes to put their name in nomination. Any active, registered, fully-initiated parish member, at least 25 years of age, is eligible to run for Trustee-Secretary.

According to Wisconsin State Statute 187.19, "trustees are to be selected from and by the congregation." Among other duties, the Trustee Secretary serves as an ex-officio member of the Parish Pastoral Council, the Finance Council, is a member of the Board of Directors of the parish corporation, signs proxy documents and all corporate reports, and signs parish checks with Trustee Treasurer, and the Parish Director.

Nominations will close on Sunday, April 19. The election will take place at the Annual Meeting on Sunday, May 3.

"Earth is God's gift to us. . . it is our Common Home." (Pope Francis "Laudato Si")



This Week's Vision: Care for our Common Home. We only have one planet to live on. It is truly a gift, without which we would not be able to exist. The air, water, habitat will only provide for us and our grandchildren if we take care of it.

With increasing air pollution, ocean acidification and over-use of ground water, heavy metal contamination of soil, biodiversity loss, and climate change's impact on flooding, drought and forest fires, it's easy to see our serious need for improved Earth stewardship. Respect and care for the Earth is a sign of God's grace in the world.

Action Changes: Whether picking up an errant piece of someone else's litter, driving the speed limit or using a lead-removing water filter, every offering we make helps to renew the Earth. Lenten Observances for Fast and Abstinence

- Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat each Friday of Lent.
- Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, should fast on Good Friday. Hence, on that day they should eat only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during that day. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59th birthday.



Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

Pontifical Good Friday Collection

Pope Leo has asked our parish to support the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, which helps Christians in the Holy Land, where they are now less than 2% of the population. Your support is essential to help the Church minister in parishes, provide Catholic schools, and offer religious education. The Pontifical Good Friday Collection also helps to preserve the sacred shrines of Christianity, including in Jerusalem, Nazareth, and Bethlehem, to name only a few.

The pandemic had hit Christians in the Holy Land particularly hard. Most of them depend on pilgrimages for work. The war and now the Iranian conflict have made their situation even more dire. In these times of crisis, the Pontifical Good Friday Collection is necessary to meet the basic needs of the People of God still living in this Land to maintain a Christian presence where the Church was born. 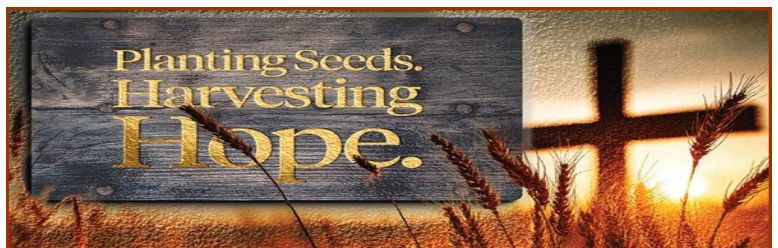

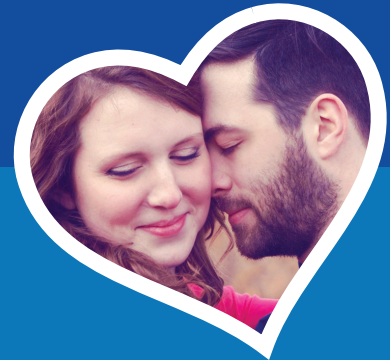
