## 4th Sunday of Easter

*John 10:1-10*

*"I am the good shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." John 10:11*

My most boring job was working at an insurance company as a college student. My main task? Filing. Now imagine if I had told my supervisor, "I just want you to know, I'm willing to die for these files." She would have called a psychiatrist — or at least security.

There is something absurd in Jesus' words in today's Gospel: **"I am the good shepherd... I lay down my life for the sheep."** (John 10:11) It sounds noble, until you think about it. No one dies for sheep. Not a hired hand. Not even a good shepherd. Sheep are important, sure, but not worth a human life.

And yet, Jesus insists: *I will die for them.* The crowd understandably responds: **"He is out of his mind."**

C.S. Lewis once said that Jesus does not leave us the option of calling him merely a good teacher. If someone speaks like Him, he is either lying, crazy, or telling the truth. John's Gospel won't let us stay sentimental. Jesus means it. He reveals a love that surpasses logic — a love that measures worth not by strength or success, but by the willingness to suffer unto death.

The Good Shepherd's madness is mercy. His cross makes no earthly sense and yet it makes divine sense. He lays down His life not for kings or saints, but for sheep — for the ordinary, the unworthy, for you and me.

Think of someone who may feel unworthy of love. Do something simple and generous for them, not because they deserve it, but because Jesus did the same for you. — *Father John Muir* ©LPi

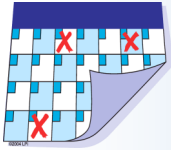

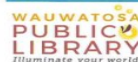

### From The Earth Ministry: Why is Bamboo in the News?



Bamboo plants are a type of grass. They grow amazingly fast, from inches to feet per

day. Bamboo is native to China, Japan, central and southern Africa, India, Southeast Asia, and most of South America and Central America. There are even native species of bamboo in the American Southeast.

Bamboo is being studied as a sustainable alternative material because it grows very quickly and matures in one year. It has an extensive root system which is good for erosion control. When the aboveground shoots are harvested, new shoots arise from the root without need for replanting. Bamboo requires less water than many alternatives (cotton, hardwood trees.) It is also good at absorbing atmospheric CO2, one of the greenhouse gases causing global warming. Bamboo is fairly resistant to pests and diseases and doesn't require pesticides or other toxins. Bamboo can be used for a variety of purposes: fabrics, flooring, and many household items often made of wood or plastic (e.g. toothbrush handles.) Bamboo is biodegradable, unlike plastics.

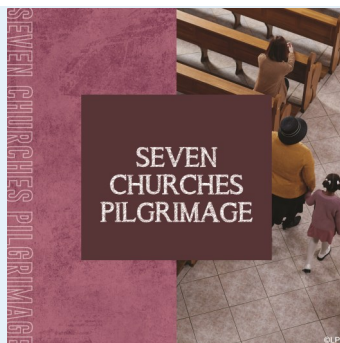
Bamboo is not the perfect solution to everything. A future article will discuss concerns.

### Devotions, Explained! Seven Churches Pilgrimage

The Seven Churches Pilgrimage is the practice of visiting seven different churches on Holy Thursday, in imitation of the journey of Christ on the eve of his crucifixion.

The devotion is thought to have originated in sixteenth-century Rome, where pilgrims — likely led by St. Philip Neri — would visit the seven major basilicas there: St. Peter's in the Vatican, St. John Lateran, St. Paul Outside the Walls, St. Mary Major, St. Sebastian Outside the Walls, St. Lawrence Outside the Walls and Santa Croce in Gerusalemme.

Pilgrims undertaking this journey anywhere in the world can visit any seven churches while adoring Christ in the Blessed Sacrament upon the Altar of Repose, fulfilling His request of His disciples to stay with Him as He awaited His Passion. There are specific Scripture passages that pilgrims can meditate upon at each altar. ©LPi

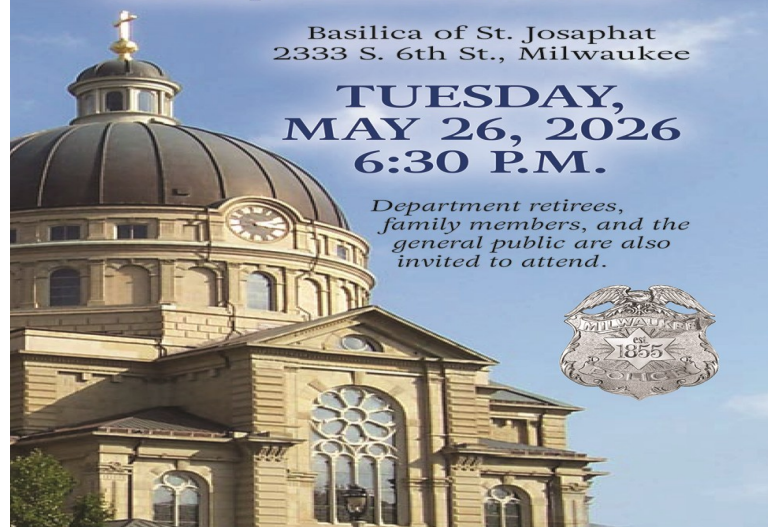

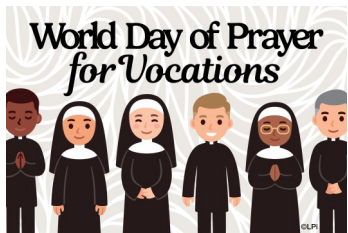

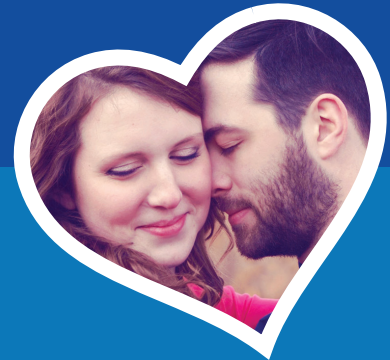
