18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 14:13-21

In his song, "Lose Yourself," the artist Eminem raps, **"the mood all changed."**

We all know that moment when the mood changes, when life turns from lighthearted to deadly serious. That happens in today's Gospel. Jesus has just heard that John the Baptist, His cousin, forerunner, and friend, has been murdered. As Matthew tells us, **"When Jesus heard of it, he withdrew in a boat to a deserted place by himself."** Until now, He had been teaching in parables and healing quietly. But John's death signals a new phase. The shadow of the Cross begins to fall. Evil shows its teeth.

And how does Jesus respond? Not with rage or despair. He goes to a lonely place to go into deep communion with His Father. From that silence comes action. He feeds the multitude. Out of grief comes generosity. Out of sorrow, life.

This is the rhythm of every disciple's life. When tragedy or violence breaks our hearts, we face a choice. We can react, or we can retreat into prayer — like and with Christ. This is the hidden place where pain becomes compassion and compassion becomes self-gift.

Lord Jesus, when life intensifies, draw me into Your quiet strength. In that hidden place with You and the Father, turn my heartbreak into the bread of love for the world. Amen. — Father John Muir ©LPi

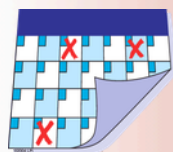

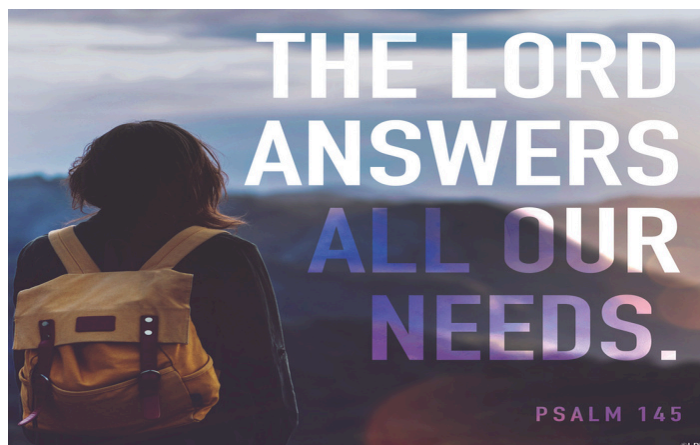

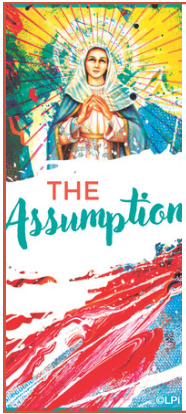

GAC is a downtown Milwaukee nonprofit that supports adults experiencing mental illness in finding employment, pursuing educational goals, and fighting isolation through community. We are a voluntary, nonclinical organization where members work side-by-side with staff to focus on whatever personal goals are most important to them. Rather than providing therapy or medical treatment, we offer opportunities, encouragement, and meaningful work that help people build confidence, develop skills, and reconnect with their communities. Please note we do not discourage clinical treatment; we encourage those who need it to pursue it and will help refer people to the proper support needed. We just focus on a different aspect of life outside of medication or therapy.

At Grand Avenue Club, every day is centered around purpose and belonging. Members can gain job experience, receive support in returning to school, participate in wellness and social activities, share meals, build friendships, and contribute to the day-to-day operation of the Club. Whether someone is looking for their first job in years, hoping to earn a degree, or simply searching for a welcoming place where they feel valued, Grand Avenue Club provides a community where people can grow, recover, and thrive at their own pace.

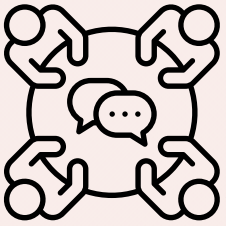

Merger Listening Sessions

Since the announcement of Archbishop Grob's approval of Fr. P.C.'s request to merge St. Therese and St. Vincent Pallotti Parishes, there have been questions and confusion about what comes next. From the Earth Ministry:

Residential solar is a financially sound long-term investment for many homeowners. Electricity rates continue to climb and installing home solar panels locks in your energy cost. The savings from reduced electricity bills over 25-30 years provides a strong return on investment. There are still smaller rebates available for residential solar, though the tax incentives of recent years have ended.

Fossil fuels damage the earth when extracted, cannot be easily replaced and leave waste products that damage the earth's atmosphere. Solar power provides energy from a renewable source and with a far smaller negative ecologic footprint.

A home solar installation includes solar panels, inverter(s), mounting equipment, monitoring equipment, and an optional solar battery to store excess electricity for your use later. This rises in importance if there are frequent disruptions in local electrical service.

Some local municipalities have sustainability departments and arrange solar buying groups for their residents. The volume of the group buy decreases the individual purchase cost for a new system. Wauwatosa and Milwaukee currently have a group buy underway that ends in September 2026. For more information try this website.

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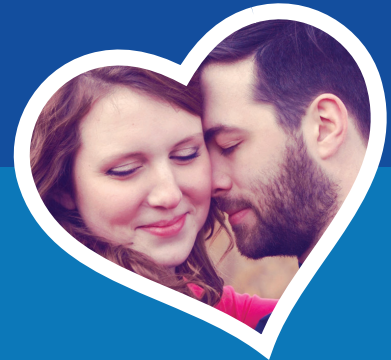
